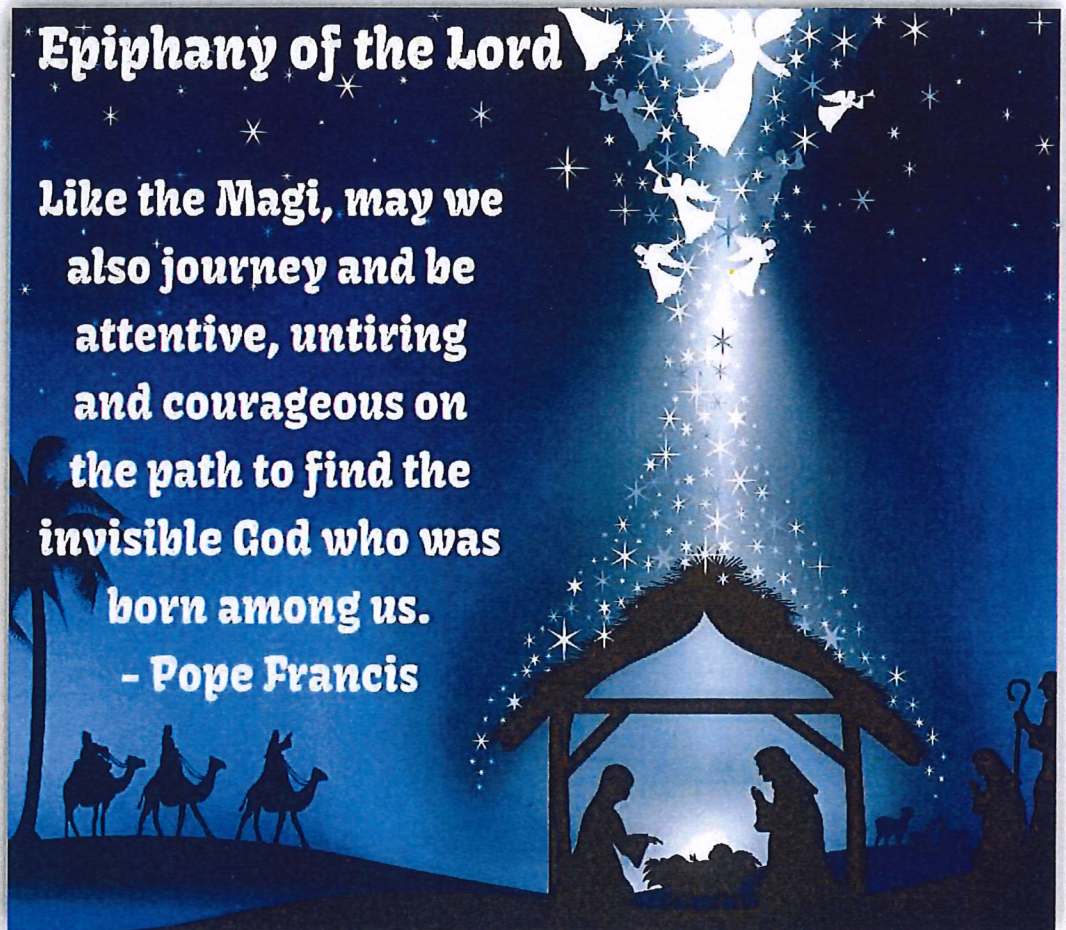

Pope Francis noted that before the Magi could worship Jesus in Bethlehem, they had to undertake a long journey. "A journey," he said, "always involves a change." For us, too, our journey through life involves many changes, even mistakes and failures that can nonetheless become learning experiences. "With the passage of time," the Pope said, "life's trials and difficulties, experience in faith, help to purify our hearts, making them humbler and thus more open to God." Instead of becoming discouraged by the difficulties we experience in life, he continued, "we should make them opportunities to progress towards the Lord Jesus... By keeping our gaze fixed on the Lord, we will find the strength needed to persevere with renewed joy."
