



# The Mission: Seeing With Spiritual Eyes (The Hope That Is In You)

Join us from 6:00 -7:30 pm for the spiritual enrichment mission and followed by coffee, cookies and fellowship in the Narthex.

# Sunday, February 6

Night 1: The Gift of Jesus
