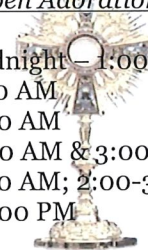
2022-2023 PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION

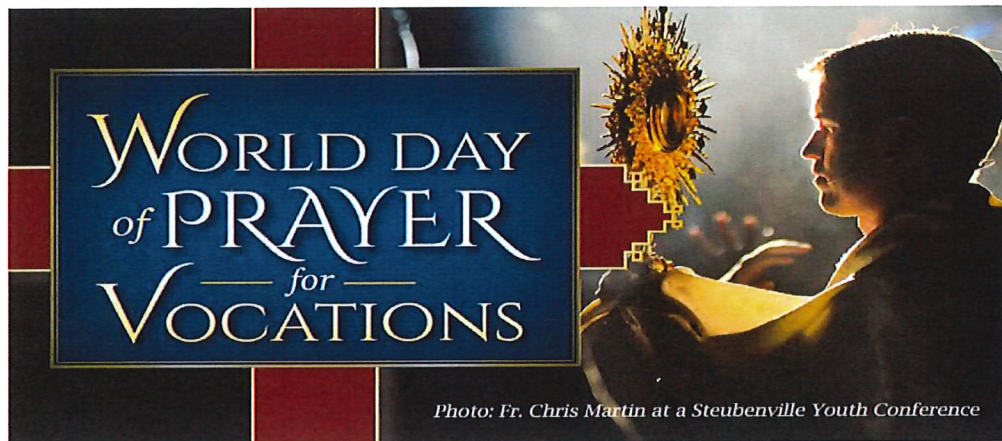
