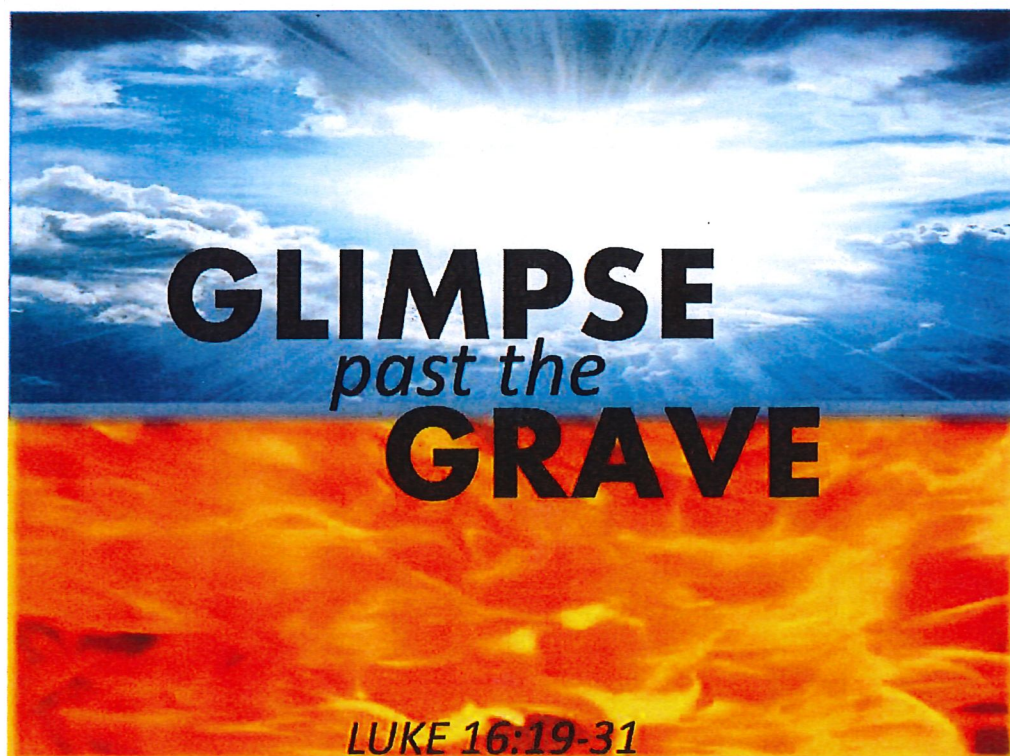

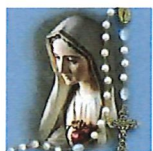
Welcome to the Christian Community:

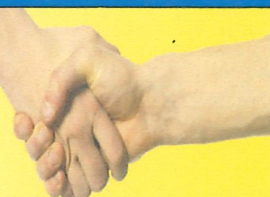
