

- Fast & Abstain on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. All Catholics are obliged to fast, with no eating between meals on those two days.
- Personal Fasting: Try to find opportunities during Lent to compliment your fasts with prayer, frequent attendance at daily Mass, and positive works of charity and mercy.
