

Saints on Confession "If you have an ugly toad inside you, my son, let it out! As I have always advised you, the first thing you must mention is what you wouldn't like anybody to know. Once the toad has been let out in confession, how well one feels." – St. Josemaria Escriva "Sweep your conscience clean with the broom of confession." -- St. Thomas of Villanova
