What is the Sacrament of Confession? "Confession is an act of honesty and courage; an act of entrusting ourselves, beyond sin, to the mercy of a loving and forgiving God. It is an act of the prodigal son who returns to his Father and is welcomed by Him with the kiss of peace. -- Pope St. John Paul II. Three conditions are necessary for the sacrament of Confession: contrition, which is sorrow for sin, together with a purpose of amendment; confession of sins without any omission; and satisfaction by means of good works. -- "The priest to whom confession is made is the delegate of Christ, Who is the Judge of the living and the dead". -- Thomas Aquinas. Why Should We Make Our Confession? 1. To cleanse our souls. 2. To grow our relationship with the Lord. 3. To experience Divine Forgiveness. 4. To relinquish our guilt. 5.
