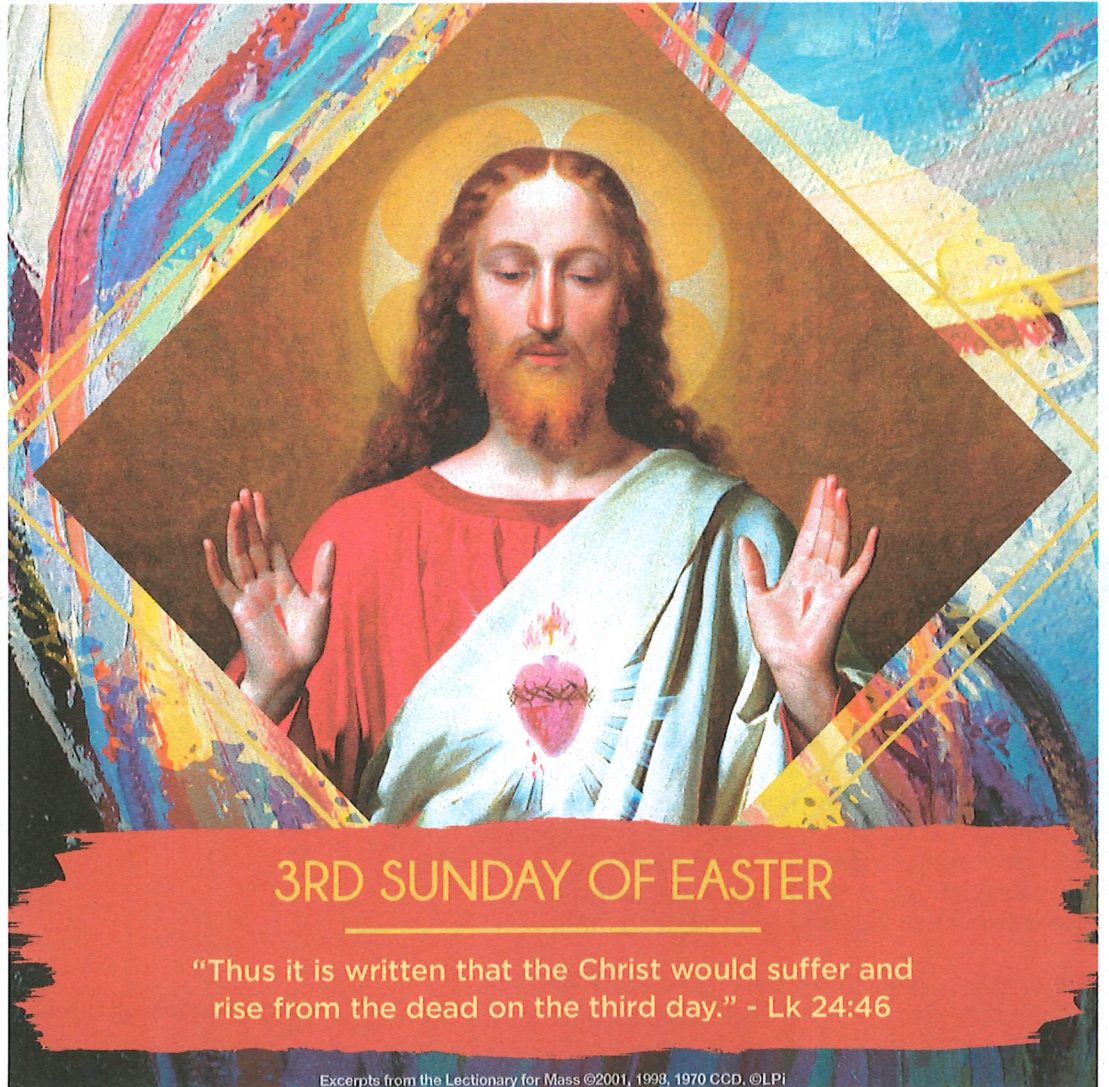

What is Perpetual Adoration?

Perpetual Adoration is a Eucharistic devotion made up of members that unite together in taking hours of adoration before the Most Blessed Sacrament, both during the day and throughout the night, seven days a week.

Putting our faith into action by going to Adoration is an authentic witness to our belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the blessed Sacrament. To see Jesus visibly present under the appearance of the small white host is much more intimate than hidden away in the tabernacle. It adds an extra responsibility on the adorers to be sure to be faithful to the hours they are scheduled. Please consider devoting an hour of your time to spend it with Jesus whether it's reading a book or the bible, praying the rosary or even to just sit and relax and enjoy the sweet peace that comes from simply being in the Presence of God. The mere fact that you take time out at a specific time each week to spend an hour with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament pleases Him very much and is in itself a prayer of great faith.
