

**Archdiocese of Kansas City** 

With deep sorrow for the suffering of victims and survivors of abuse, the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas ("Archdiocese") announces that former priest Dennis Schmitz, who was laicized from the priesthood in 2005, has been the subject of additional substantiated allegations of sexual abuse of minors and adults over whom he held a position of authority. Mr. Schmitz served in a number of locations and capacities in the timeframe of the abuse in the late 1990s and early 2000s, including St. Joseph in Shawnee, Bishop Miege in Roeland Park, St. Mary and St. Anthony in Kansas City, St. Lawrence Catholic Campus Center in Lawrence, and as Vocation Director for the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas. Additionally, in October of 2002, Mr. Schmitz was convicted of indecent liberties with a child that occurred in 1998. He was removed from parish ministry, and the Church began the process of laicization. Mr. Schmitz was sentenced to 32 months in prison and was ordered to register on the Kansas Sexual Offender Registry for 25 years. The end of this 25-year term is January 24, 2030.

In making this announcement, the Archdiocese reaffirms its commitment to all who have been harmed by an agent of the Church, to atone for the harm, and to accompany survivors using restorative processes as they work toward healing and peace.

Mr. Schmitz served in the following parishes/schools during his parish ministry in the Archdiocese: St. Ann, Prairie Village; Queen of the Holy Rosary, Overland Parish; Bishop Miege High School, Roeland Park; St. Joseph, Shawnee; Vocation Director, Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas; St. Mary-St. Anthony, Kansas City, Kansas; St. Lawrence Catholic Campus Center, Lawrence; St. Gregory, Marysville
