

The Best Gift You Can Give Your Mom for Mother's Day

Probably the most common suffering I hear about most from mothers and grandmothers is that their children have fallen away from their Catholic faith, possibly even from Christianity altogether.

As parents who practice their faith, it is easy to feel like we have failed in our primary mission if our kids and/or their kids don't have a living relationship with Jesus and His Church. We naturally blame ourselves for any lack of faith in them.

To put it in perspective, even if we were perfect parents, our children could still fall away. Just look at the example of Jesus: despite His perfect love for His followers, everyone but John, His Mother, and a few women abandoned Him out of fear during His Passion and Death.

That being said, the best gift we can give our mothers and grandmothers, whether living or deceased, is to recommit our lives to Jesus, His Church, and the practice of the faith.

What joy our mothers would have to know that we are keeping Jesus at the center of our lives, preparing ourselves to spend eternity with Him heaven, rather than the horrible alternative!

This is also the best way to fulfill the fourth commandment of honoring our mother and father: upholding the faith they passed on to us, however imperfectly that may have been.

So where do we begin to make such a recommitment of ourselves to Jesus?

Here are my "Big Three":


- 1. Make a good confession, especially if it has been more than a year since your last one
- 2. Make Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation a non-negotiable in your schedule, even during the summer, on vacation, and at tournaments!
- 3. Spend a minimum of 15-30 minutes with Jesus to start every day: praying with the Bible, the rosary, journaling, or whatever helps you receive God's love for you!

If you do these things, you will bless everyone else around you, have greater peace and joy in your life, and give your mom the best possible Mother's Day gift!

#### Announcement from the Archdiocese

With deep sorrow for the suffering of victims and survivors of abuse, I share the sad news that Father John "Fidelis" Forrester, OSB, and Father Donald Redmond, OSB, have both recently been the subject of substantiated allegations of abuse. As a result, Fr. Forrester has been added to the Archdiocesan list of clerics who have been the subject of substantiated allegations of sexual abuse of minors. Fr. Redmond was previously published on this list, but additionally, Fr. Redmond has substantiated allegations of abuse against an adult.

Peter and Paul from 1957-1961, and Fr. Redmond served in ministry here from 1961-1964. Fr. Forrester passed away in 2002. Fr. Redmond was removed from public ministry in 2002 and died in 2019.

Please be assured of the commitment by the Archdiocese and St. Benedict's Abbey to all who have been harmed by an agent of the Church to atone for the harm and to accompany survivors using restorative processes as they work toward healing and peace.
