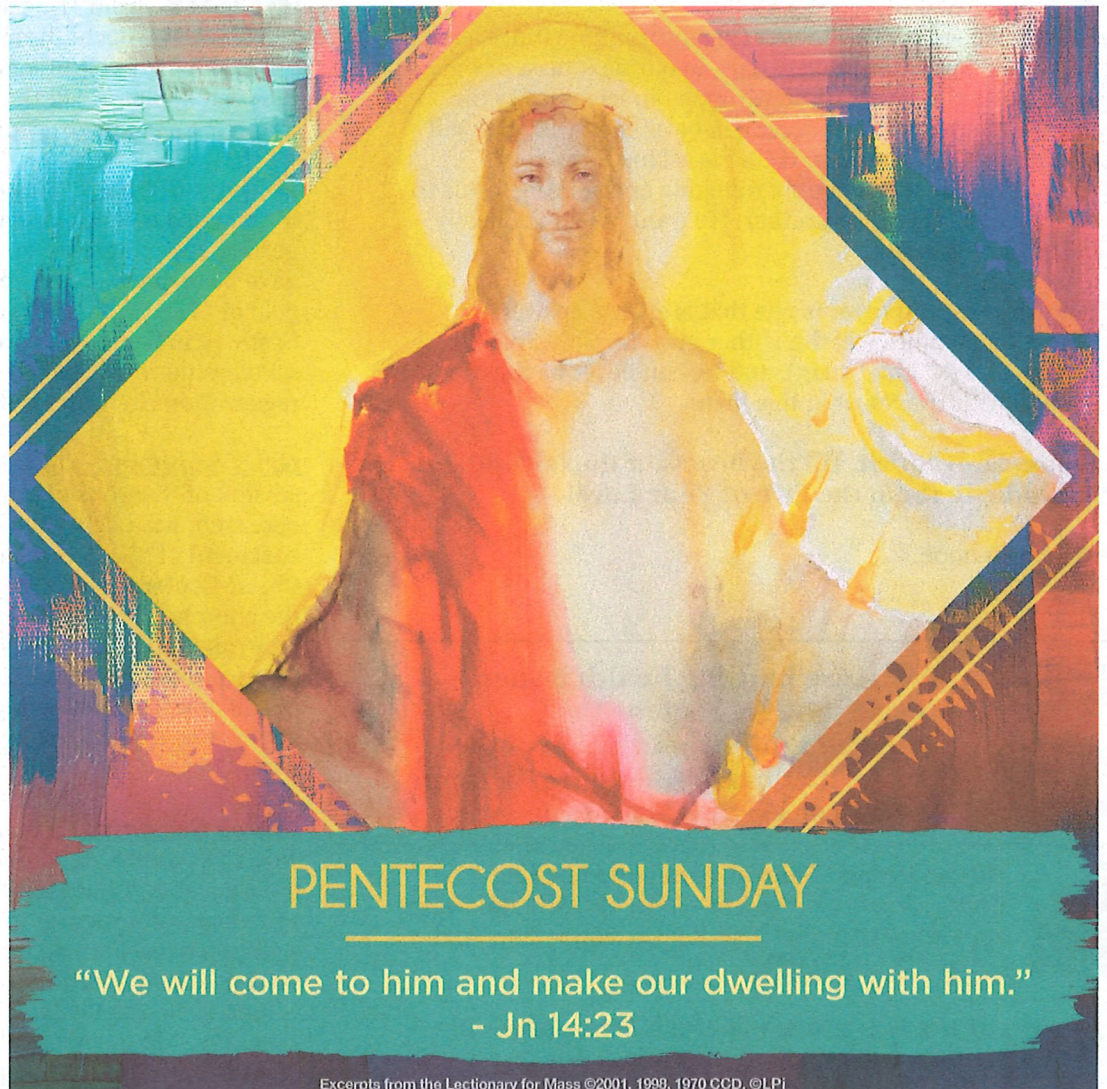

## The Power of "Come, Holy Spirit"

Happy Solemnity of Pentecost!

This is probably my favorite feast day because everything else in the liturgical year builds up to this moment: Jesus was born, died, rose, and ascended into heaven so that He could pour out His Spirit of Power and Love upon us!

If we are in a state of grace, the three Persons of the Trinity dwell in our souls in order to fulfill the promise that Jesus made that He would be with us until the end of time...how amazing!

Our religion is different than any other 1) because God is primarily the one seeking us out rather than the reverse and 2) because He desires to transform us into Himself and not just have us be "good people." This transformation happens through the Fire of the Holy Spirit.

One of the shortest and most powerful prayers (after simply the Name of Jesus) is, **"COME, HOLY SPIRIT!"**

Every time we say this prayer (ideally multiple times a day) before we begin our prayer time, do our next task, or have an important conversation, we open ourselves up to the power of the Spirit so that we can be aligned with His will and receive His strength. If God is asking us to do something, He is not simply watching and waiting for us to do it by our own power; rather, He wants to do the heavy lifting through us!

This three-word prayer is one that is always answered ("How much more will the Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask" Luke 11:13), and we can never be filled enough with His Spirit in this life!

**Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of the faithful, and enkindle in them the Fire of Your Love!**
